



## COVID-19 PROTOCOLS

LiTE-HAUS follows a 2G + mask policy (*geimpft, genesen*) People who have proof of being fully vaccinated, or recovered from COVID-19 are allowed entry to the galerie, but everyone wears a mask. Visitors are given a wristband to identify that they passed through our door check policy.

### Hygiene - Indoors

1. Space and furniture is cleaned daily, and Isopropyl alcohol is sprayed onto frequently used surfaces such as light switches, windows handles, and door handles.
2. Free hand sanitizer is provided to guests, with pump bottles available in each room.
3. The lavatory is open to guests so they may wash their hands.
4. Windows are kept open for air circulation, and often the doors are open - weather permitting.
5. Each of the 3 public gallery rooms have filters

### Hygiene - Outdoors

1. Windows sills and outside handles on doors are cleaned daily and sprayed with Isopropyl alcohol. We utilize our terrace and sidewalk during Vernissage events to encourage visitors to enjoy their beverages outside. Additional social distancing signage is posted on our windows.

### Social Distancing - Indoors

1. We encourage social distancing due to the rise of virus variants. Signage is placed throughout the gallery to remind visitors of social distance protocols. Currently, due to our size, we allow a maximum of 24 visitors at a time (8 per room).

### Contact Tracing

1. All visitors are required to register via iPad app SignUpAnywhere, and LUCA. They provide full name, address, email, and telephone number. This data is maintained in a confidential spreadsheet for the required minimum period.
2. Likewise visitors who make private appointments via the AcuityScheduling app, provide the same contact information.
